$\square$ Create an environment that reinforces safety, e.g. Breakfast Club
$\square$ Bonding activities between staff a nd students
$\square$ Praise, even for minor successes/achievements
$\square$ Buddy system/mentoring system
$\square$ Get to know and engage with student interests, e.g. Star Wars, Lego
$\square$ Acknowledge them in the moming "Good to see you at school today!"
$\square$ Moming Circle
$\square$ Establish Student interests
$\square$ Be consistent and predictable
$\square$ Outdooractivities
$\square$ Have a Teacher-mentor
$\square$ Staff recognise, label and give feedback to students rega rding emotional states
$\square$ Say hello, a nod, wink, small, "are you ok?", shake boys' hands in the moming, give hi-fives
$\square$ Compliment students
$\square$ Give unconditional positive regard
$\square$ Active listening
$\square$ Get to know student "triggers" to pre-empt an "episode"
$\square$ Being there - giving your time, being available, even if you have to take time and get back to a student later
$\square$ Remembernames
$\square$ Be fair and firm
$\square$ Modelling character strengths and positive behaviour and communication
$\square$ Positively reinforce the good behaviours as much as possible and state the good behaviour
$\square$ Allow students to shine
$\square$ Provide them with jobs/leadership opportunities
$\square$ Show trust
$\square$ Give praise and recognition when it is appropriate
$\square$ Token economy with individual and whole class rewards, Dojo points, "warm and fuzzy jar", rewards
$\square$ Communicate and form relationships with parents and carers
$\square$ Remembering what students have told you about themselves
$\square$ Reminding students that we asteacher are human too, opening up yourself (within reason)
$\square$ Making the first point of contact positive for kids as they a mive everydayAllow students to present PowerPoints on their special interests
$\square$ Playing games (sport/board games)
$\square$ Special interest clubs
$\square$ Circle Time (Friendship/Belonging Sections)
$\square$ Have a 'Playmate spot' on the playground where students can find a friend and game to play
$\square$ Positive Tracking (See: Friendly Kids, Friendly Classroom)
